Each collects 15-20kgs of waste everyday




This waste gets recycled which otherwise would have landed to landfills






Milestones



- Three Facilities
 - Piyar and Kiran at Ramapir Tekda and Sabarmati respectively for purchase and sale of waste material.
 - Mausal, a community space for sorting the waste material.
- Facilitated recycling of 15,00,000kgs of wastes.
- Distributed a sum of Rs.1,20,00,000 against the waste purchased from Paryavaran Mitras.
- Shared a profit of nearly Rs.18,00,000 in terms of grocery, education fee etc.
- Employment to a 40+member team.


